## **Opening**

The Centre Leader, Dr. Daprim Samuel Ogaji declared the meeting open at 2:10 p.m after an opening prayer said by the Project Auditor, Mr. Aselemi Umor. ### Agenda

### **Matters arising**

#### **List of Officers**

The task of monitoring and evaluation was assigned to the Academic Programmes Coordinator. Short-term assignment for the various sub-committees prepared by the Centre Leader were approved by the management committee.

### Djibouti Trip

The Centre Leader Informed Management Committee that there would be an official launch of all the Centres awarded under the World Bank ACE Impact Project in 2018 between February 18 and 22 2019 in Djibouti.

### **PUTOR Logo**

Centre Management Committee agreed to adopt a simple logo containing the University logo and ACE-PUTOR written below for the Centre like CEFOR is doing.

### **Any other Business (AOB)**

Mr. Aselemi Umor noted that Committees need to be set up as required by World Bank such as the Procurement Committee, Budget Committee, and Audit Committee. The Centre Leader was asked to provide the guidelines for setting up the committee.

In the absent of any other matter, Dr K. C. Patrick-Iwuanyanwu moved the motion for adjournment and this was seconded by Dr Catherine Ikewuchi. The meeting was adjourned to the 29<sup>th</sup> of November 2018.
