Introduction

ACE IMPACT Project

The African Centres of Excellence (ACE) impact project was designed to improve the quality, quantity of PG education and improve regional specialisation and participation. ACEs like PUTOR were set-up to be regional Centres that would promote collaboration and interdisciplinary research; build strong reputation for excellence; support teaching, learning, assessment of students; provide uninterrupted research and learning Calendar.

ACE-PUTOR emerged from the 2018 round of competitive bid for Africa Centre of Excellence (ACE) in various fields of human endeavour offered in African Universities. The University of Port Harcourt successfully attracted another African Centre of Excellence focused on Public Health and Toxicological Research (ACE-PUTOR) during this exercise. This was an addition to the existing Centre of Excellence for Oilfield Chemical Research which had recorded impressive performance in the last round of selection of ACE 1 Centres and was renewed in the current round of screening. The emergence of ACE-PUTOR made the University of Port Harcourt one of twelve in Nigeria hosting ACE impact projects and one of three (including Bayero University and University of Lagos) hosting two ACE-Impact projects each.

Brief description of Centre

The Africa Centre of Excellence in Public Health and Toxicological Research (ACE-PUTOR) is a regional Centre established to promote collaboration and interdisciplinary research; improve the practice of public health, biochemistry, toxicology, and nursing; produce cutting-edge research projects to solve public health issues arising from oil and gas sectors and undertake consultancy and community services. The Centre is supported by the World Bank Group (WBG), French Development Agency (AFD), the Association of African Universities (AAU) and the National Universities Commission (NUC).

VISION

To be a centre for innovative research and academic training, recognised for local relevance, international excellence and global impacts in public health, toxicology and nursing sciences.

MISSION

To provide an enabling environment for students and faculties to discover and nurture their full potentials in delivering innovative research and human capacity development.

OBJECTIVES

1. To develop and effectively manage relevant postgraduate programmes in public health, toxicology and nursing science.
2. To deliver relevant short courses in public health, toxicology and nursing science to mid-

career professionals.

3. To enhance participation of students and faculties in internships & exchange experiences.
4. To develop local, regional and international partnerships and linkages with industries, public sectors and academic institutions.
5. To implement priority interventions focused on remediation of developmental challenges related to public health, toxicology, and nursing.

RESEARCH

Research is core to the activity of the centre and key areas will focus on health issue related to oil and gas exploration and exploitation. The nature of research conducted in the Centre include reviews (narrative and systematic) and empirical (observational and interventional) research that would improve the health of the community and enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of public and environmental health system as an integral part of the overall socioeconomic development of the people. Faculty expertise and industrial partners will be involved in the supervision of research projects in the Centre.

The scope of research undertaken in the ACE-PUTOR are aimed at investigating and remediating health issues arising from oil and gas exploration in the region.

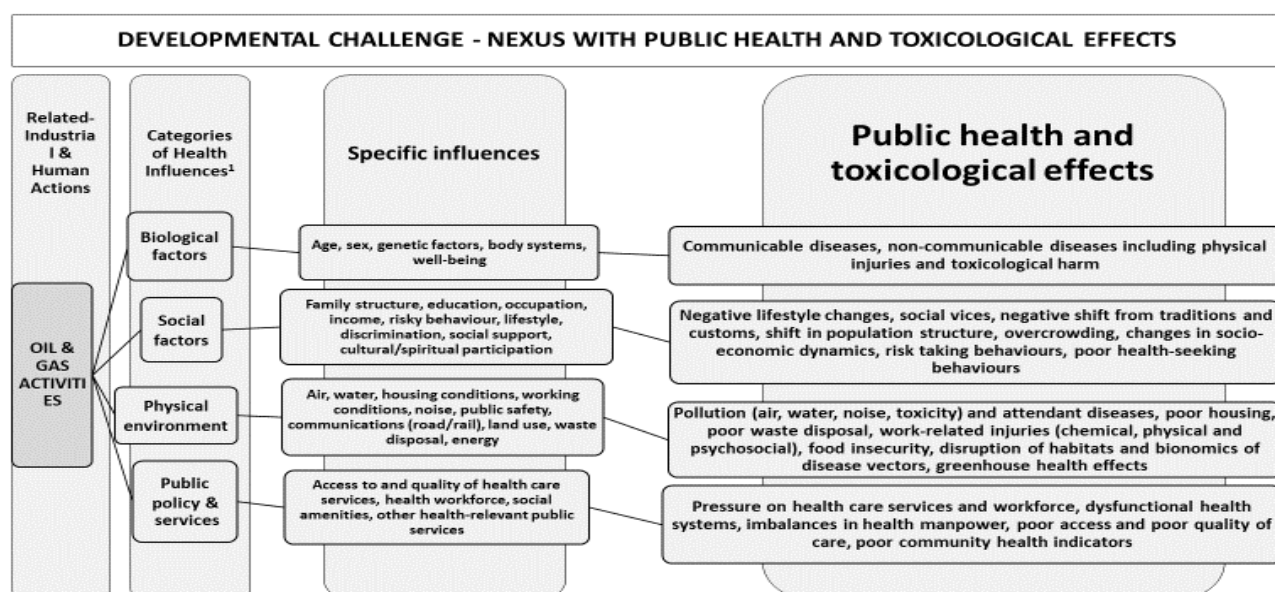


Figure 1. Public health and toxicological link with challenge

The Centre had developed high calibre human resources with the requisite teaching skills and research abilities, to handle the public health and environmental challenges hindering sustainable development in regions of Africa where oil and gas activities are on-going (Figure 1).

A comprehensive research management system was developed for the Centre since inception. All research carried out by students and faculties in the Centre utilize sound and rigorous methodologies and are conducted using standard facilities, reliable and valid tools. A repository is maintained for all research outputs of the Centre for future reference; and there is adequate support for disseminating the research findings during local, regional, and international conferences and publication in top-rated journals in related disciplines. The annual research fair of the Centre serves as a means for dissemination of the research undertaken in the Centre. This would promote adequate uptake of the evidence by industries and sector stakeholders including government and policy makers.

The research agenda of the Centre was planned in collaboration with the stakeholders in the sectors and industries. Efforts was made to ensure that this agenda is tailored to meet the local needs of the industries and the sector. The review of the research agenda is done annually in collaboration with the stakeholders on completion of each trench of research in the Centre. To achieve the research plans of the Centre, there are concerted efforts to guarantee additional investment in human and infrastructural facilities such as creation of laboratories, re-training of staff, providing access to online resources including bibliographic databases and facilitating networking with international faculties.

DEVELOPMENTAL CHALLENGES – INTERDISCIPLINARY SOLUTIONS

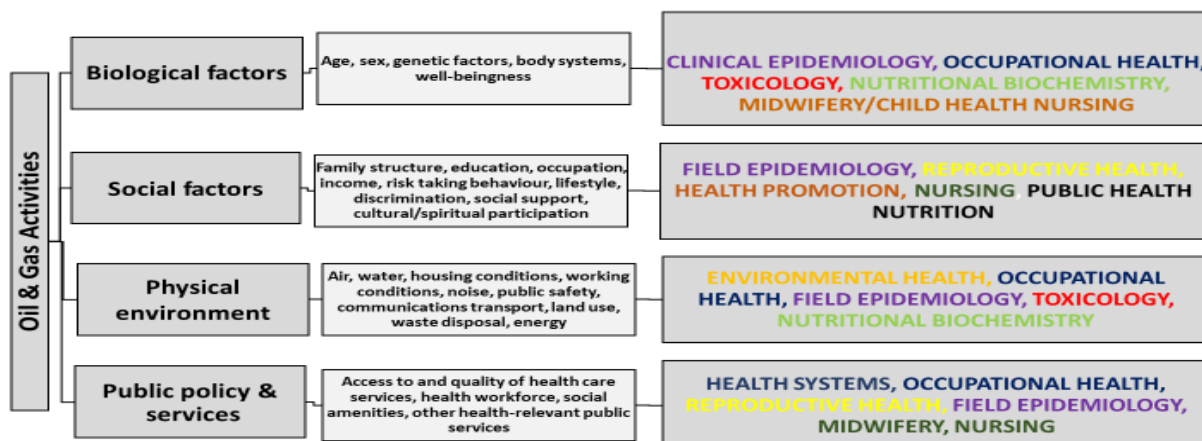


Figure 2. Inter-disciplinary solutions to developmental challenge

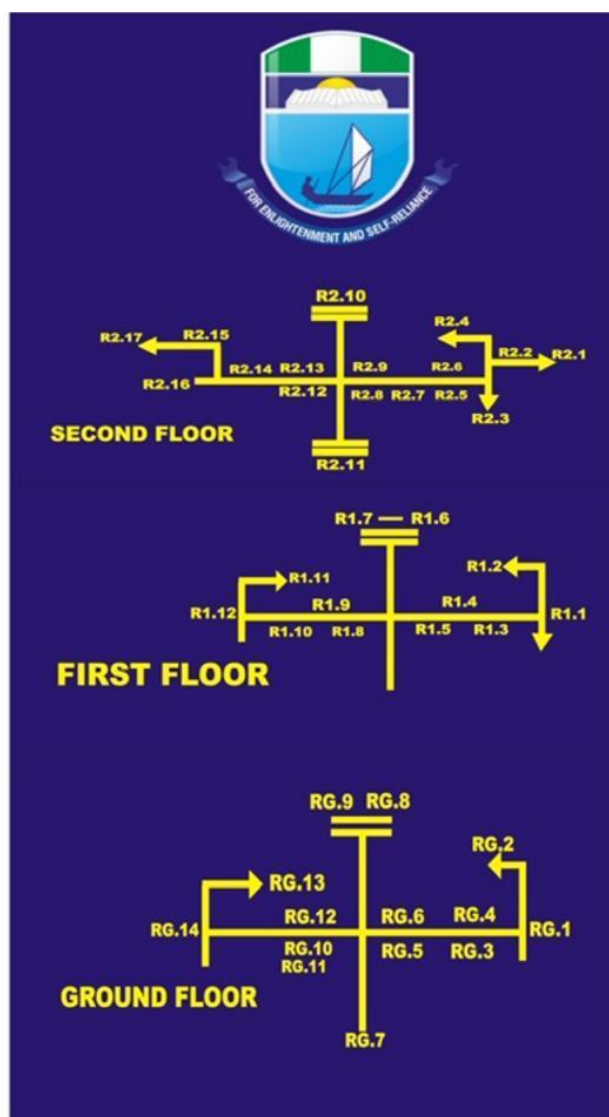

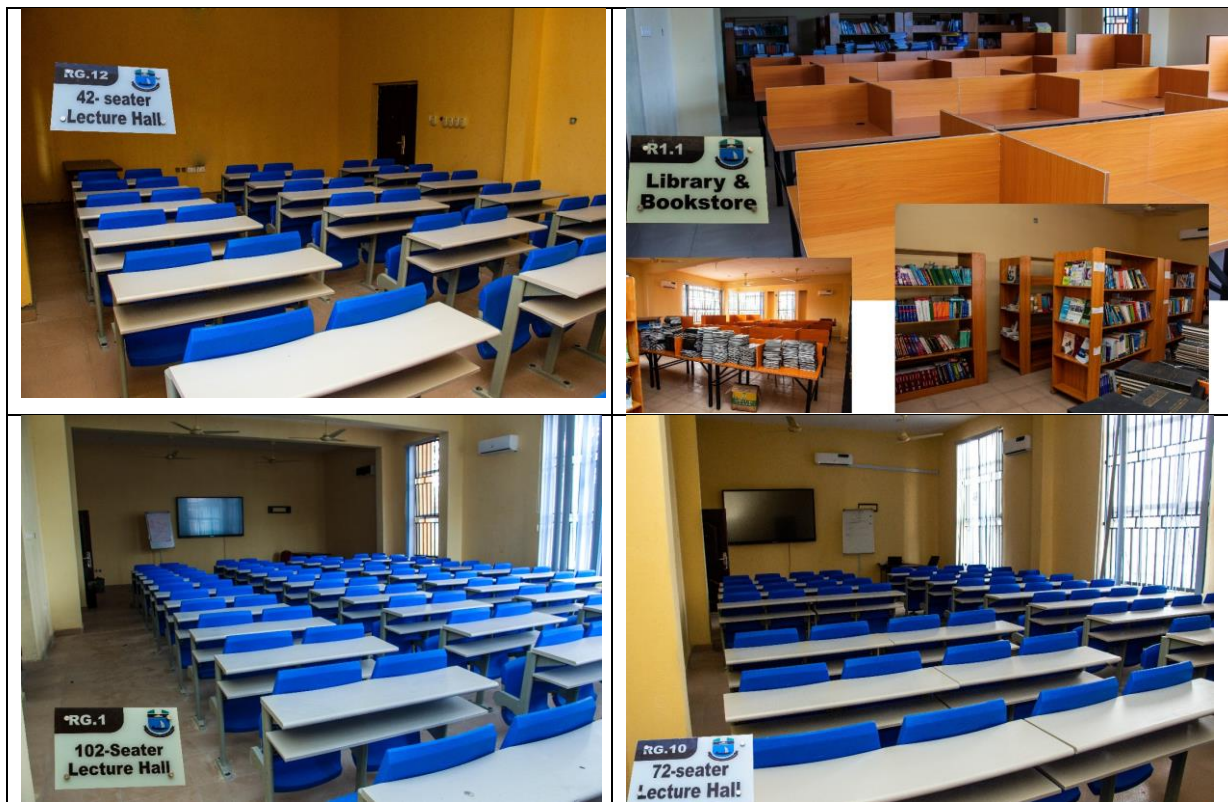

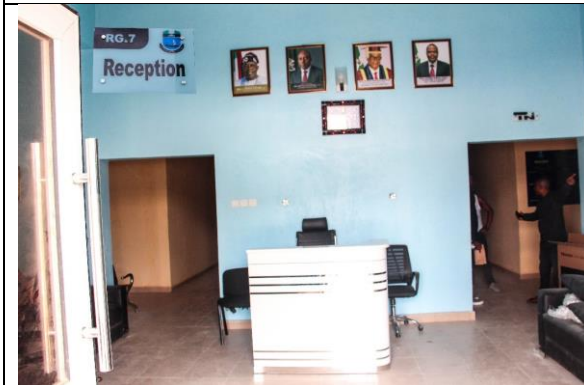
