

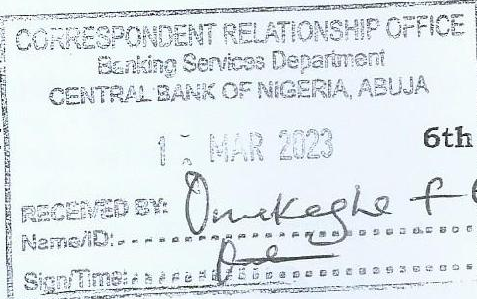



A one-day Workshop on Enhancing Academic Writing with Integrity has ended at the University of Port Harcourt with a call on stakeholders in the Academic sector to come up with a holistic and multi-dimensional approach that would effectively address the issue of academic misconduct and enhance teaching and learning.

Those were the words Vice Chancellor, of the University of Port Harcourt, Professor Owunari Georgewill at the opening of a Workshop hosted by the Africa Centre of Excellence in Public Health and Toxicological Research (ACEPUTOR) in Collaboration with the Intellectual Property and Technology Transfer Office, (IPTTO) the University of Port Harcourt.

The well-patronized event which attracted many Postgraduate students and Faculty members held on Tuesday, June 27, 2023.

Other speakers at the Workshop were Ikechukwu Ekwelibe, Team Lead, Turnitin Nigeria, and Professor Mary Iwundu, Director of Intellectual Property and Technology Transfer Office(IPTTO) UniPort.

The Workshop also featured a question-and-answer session.

The session ended on a pleasant note as the Center Leader ACE PUTOR, Professor Daprim Ogaji thanked both Faculty members and students for attending the Workshop and urged them to make good use of the opportunity the training has offered and concluded by saying that as the BEST ACE CENTRE in the African sub-region, the centre would continue to produce highly skilled and motivated Public health professionals through cutting-edge research that would contribute to building the human resource and knowledge base for development in Africa.

REPORT ON ENHANCING ACADEMIC WRITING AND INTEGRITY HELD TUESDAY 27TH JUNE, 2023 AT ACE-PUTOR CLASS ROOM

PREAMBLE

The Centre for Public Health and Toxicological Research (ACE-PUTOR) in collaboration with the Intellectual and Technology Transfer Office (IPTTO) organized a one-day hybrid training workshop with the theme: Enhancing Academic Writing and Integrity. The workshop was held on Tuesday the 27th of June 2023, The participants were over two hundred (200) in attendance.

METHODOLOGY

The Centre had collaborated with Intellectual and Technology Transfer Office (IPTTO). The Centre in preparation has also writing to the University Management informing the Vice-Chancellor on about the workshop as well as the University Community. A zoom link was provided for the online participants. The workshop was held both online and onsite. The venue for onsite participants was ACE-PUTOR, Tetfund building opposite Senate building University of Port Harcourt. All faculty members and postgraduate students in the University were the target audience. The key persons include:

The Vice Chancellor, Prof. Owunari Georgewill Abraham, Centre Leader; Prof. Daprim Ogaji, Director IPTTO, the moderator, the Guest Speaker, Deans of Faculties, Directors of Units and Heads of Departments that were present. On arrival, guests were registered.

WELCOME/OPENING REMARKS

To begin the event, the National and University of Port Harcourt anthems were sung. Thereafter the Moderator, Prof K. C. Patrick-Iwuanyanwu introduced the key persons.

The Centre Leader, Prof. Daprim Ogaji, welcomed all online and onsite participants.

He informed them that the workshop was about how to add assets to plagiarism test and that the solution for the day was the Turnitin solution. He craved their indulgence to stay tuned for the lecture, prayed God's blessings on them and wished them a pleasurable time.

The Vice Chancellor, Prof. Owunari Abraham Georgewill the chief host, duly observed all protocols and welcomed all participants to the wonderful event. He commended ACE-PUTOR for contributing to enhance capacity building in the University. He also commended the commitment of the Centre Leader and his team for putting the Centre at the forefront of all World Bank Centres in the West African Sub-region and that the University owes the Centre a lot of gratitude for this feat. The Vice Chancellor informed the participants that the event of the day is part of the activities the Centre does to support the University.

Addressing the Academics, he emphasized that at the end of the workshop, it shall no longer be businesses as usual and that every paper shall not be taken as paper if it does not meet some set criteria and standard. He added that Academic writing demands clarity and upholding academic integrity for preserving dependability and ethical stance of the academia. He informed them that the University will make effort to ensure that issues of plagiarism will be taken seriously. He advised participants to pay attention to details and declared the hybrid workshop opened.

CITATION ON GUEST SPEAKER

The Moderator, Prof. K. C. Patrick-Iwuanyanwu made a citation on the guest speaker, Engr. Ikechukwu Stephen Ekwelibe Nhom, he said is the Team Lead and Technical Products Manager for Turnitin at Oraco TSL Africa, Turnitin's Sole Partner in Nigeria. He informed them that the guest speaker is a B.Sc. degree holder in Computer Engineering, Master's degree holder in information systems, Masters of Information Technology, A Microsoft Certified Solutions Expert and Certified Associate in Project Management among other achievements. He also informed them that his passion for academic saw him become one of the founding members of the Nigerian Academic Integrity Forum (NAPIF).

LECTURE/HANDS –ON TRAINING

The Guest Speaker, Engr. Ikechukwu Stephen Ekwelibe gave the lecture on Enhancing Academic Writing and Integrity. He read out a quick overview of the lecture coverage as follows:

1. Academic Integrity, the plagiarism spectrum; the different net of stages on you as both instructors, faculty and students.
2. Different Academic Integrity tools available to you at the University of Port Harcourt; how the different Turnitin product you have work.
3. Ethical usage of AI.

The guest speaker informed the participants that it is important to understand where they and the institution are in terms of academic integrity maturity which has different stages. In his explanation, after understanding Academic Integrity Maturity, it is also good to understand why people do what they do. He added that Turnitin tools tend to build your original writing skills not just check for plagiarism.

The guest speaker introduced his listeners to the Academic Integrity tools available at the University of Port Harcourt and a product work through of these tools and getting hands-on feel of how Turnitin tools work, how to interpret a Turnitin report and how to submit. Another issue he discussed was Artificial Intelligence (AI) the usage of AI in Academic setting.

Presentation on plagiarism as ethical issue and anti-plagiarism provision in the University of Port Harcourt was made by the Director of IPTTO, Prof. Mary P. Iwundu. She informed the participants that academic integrity requires hard work. According to her, avoiding plagiarism requires making the right choice, a choice for ethics. She informed them that anti-plagiarism is against plagiarism which refers to non-violation of truthfulness by not taking credit for other people's work, not stealing of other individuals' ideas not paraphrasing words or ideas of others out-of-context but rather be original and permitting appropriate sources without over-relying on them.

She continued that research ethics ought to use standards and regulations, those practices which includes the importance of the original authorship among others.

The Director of IPTTO went further to inform them that plagiarism could occur intentionally, accidentally, or even when you paraphrase and that these could be avoided by keeping track of

your sources, quoting or paraphrasing information and citing the original source. She advised them not to over-rely on other people's materials they should follow a consistent citation style, they should think to write for their writing to be strong, they should learn the elements of good grammar, they should spend time to proof-read their work, learn to subject every academic work to similarity check. She concluded that avoiding plagiarism is a mark of academic integrity.

CLOSING

After the session of question and answer, the Centre Leader, Prof. Daprim Ogaji gave the closing remarks, appreciated the guest speaker and all participants. The workshop was closed with the University anthem.
